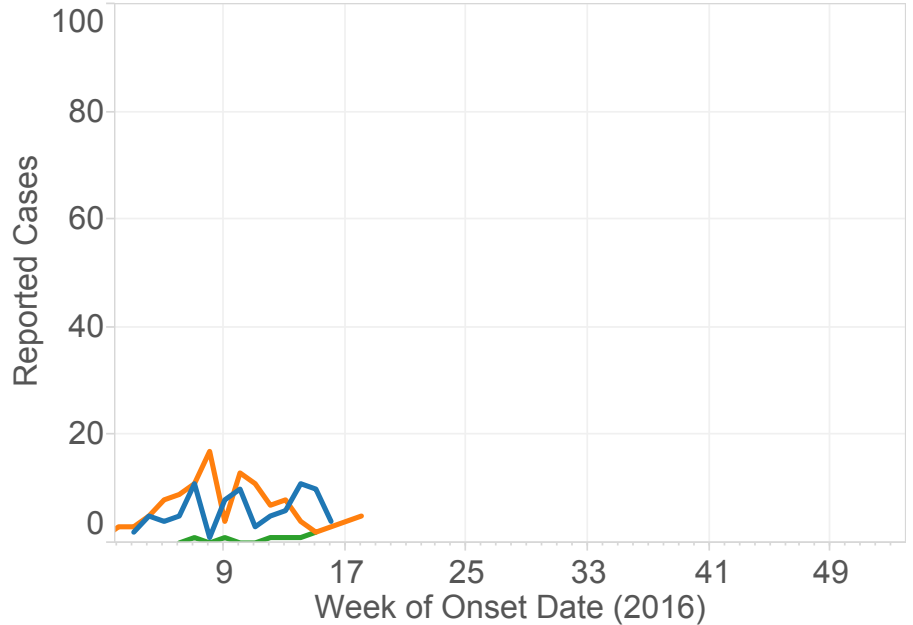

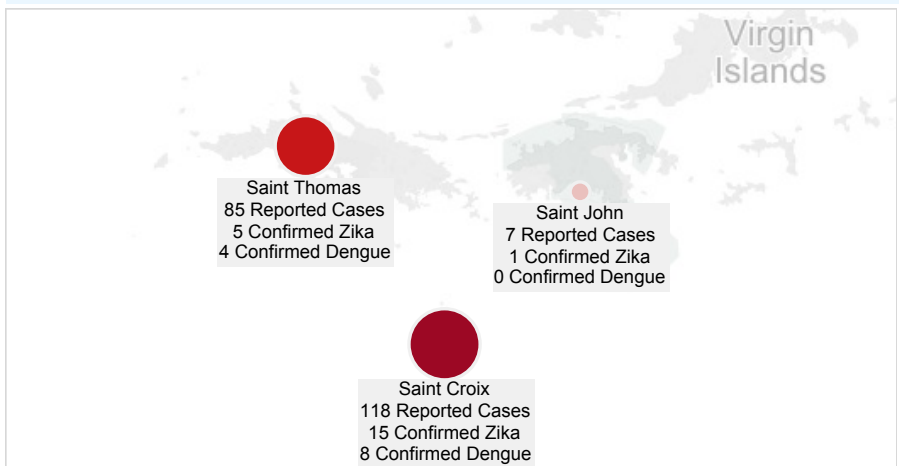

Reported Case: Any resident or visitor to the USVI diagnosed by a health care provider with suspected zika; regardless of subsequent laboratory testing.

Confirmed Case: A laboratory positive reported case with zika virus-specific nucleic acid in serum and/or IgM antibodies in serum and confirmatory plaque reduction neutralization testing to differentiate potential cross-reactive antibodies.

Lab Negative: A laboratory negative reported case without zika virus-specific nucleic acid and/or IgM antibodies in serum.

*Case counts are subject to change dependent upon receipt of diagnostic results.
