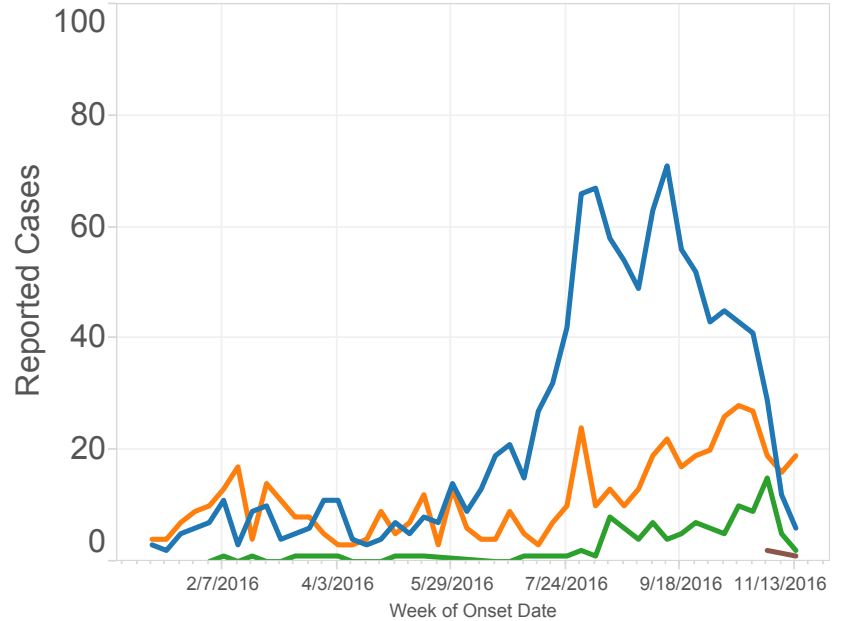

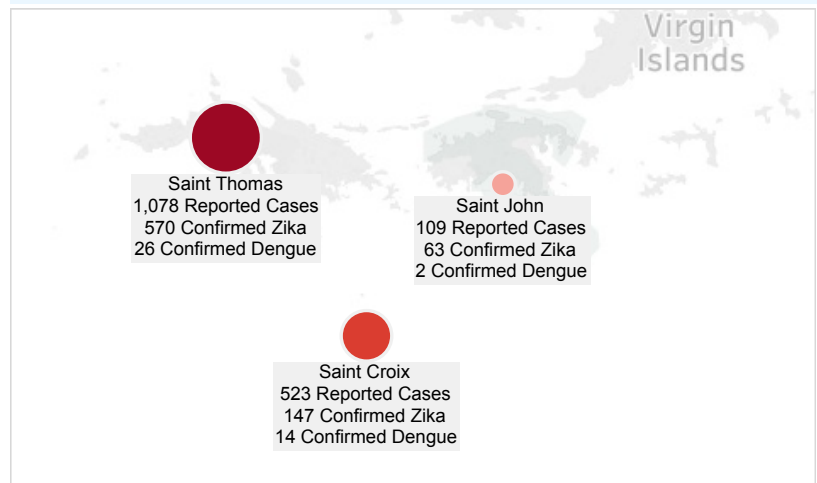

Reported/Tested: Reported includes any resident or visitor to the USVI diagnosed by a health care provider with suspected zika; regardless of subsequent laboratory testing. Tested includes any pregnant woman tested for zika regardless of symptoms.
Positive: A laboratory positive reported case with zika virus-specific nucleic acid in serum and/or IgM antibodies in serum and confirmatory plaque reduction neutralization testing to differentiate potential cross-reactive antibodies.
Negative: A laboratory negative reported case without zika virus-specific nucleic acid and/or IgM antibodies in serum.
Pending: Any reported/tested awaiting laboratory diagnosis.
