Training Overview:

The Responding to Abuse in Special Populations Using an Informed Trauma Care Model training provides public health workers and community partners with the opportunity to develop the essential behaviors and skills to effectively identify and respond to signs and symptoms of abuse in diverse populations in medical, school and business settings using an informed trauma care model.

Learning Objectives:

- Review statistics to understand scale and prevalence of domestic violence, child abuse and elder abuse.
- Review the informed Trauma Care Model to promote responsive care to abuse victims.
- Develop necessary skills to identify and address signs and symptoms of abuse with systematic steps to mitigate within the appropriate context.
- Develop understanding of primary, secondary and tertiary intervention support for special population victims of abuse and violence and implementation of organizational protocols.
- Identify strategies in psychological first aid to assist with special population victims of child abuse, elder abuse and domestic violence.
- Discuss relevant resources for referrals and ongoing victim support.
