Reopening of 2020-2021 School Year for Public School Students Delayed One Week

ST. THOMAS – In keeping with Governor Albert Bryan Jr's August 29 extension of the territory's Stay-at-Home Order, the Virgin Islands Department of Education has delayed the start of public schools for one week, with classes beginning on Mon., Sept. 14, and not Tues., Sept. 8. All students will learn from home, as previously announced.
