

## VISITOR PRECAUTIONS DURING COVID-19 OUTBREAK (for Isolated Patients)



### DON'T VISIT

If you're sick, have a fever or a confirmed case of COVID-19, you cannot visit or accompany a patient. Contact Department of Health at 340-712-6699.



### FOLLOW VISITING HOURS

No visitors allowed from 6 p.m. to 11 a.m., unless a parent or guardian of a pediatric patient. Designated visitors may visit the patient a total of twice a day for a maximum of two (2) hours per day.



### VISITORS ARE LIMITED

Patients may only have 1 visitor with them during visiting hours. No visitors under the age of 18 or over the age of 65 will be allowed. Persons with any immunocompromise (including pregnancy) will not be allowed.



### NO PERSONAL ITEMS

Visitors may not bring any personal items such as purses, backpacks, jackets or sweaters into the patient room. Cell phones may be brought in specifically to allow the patient to contact supportive family/friends, unless patient is intubated.



### SCREENING

Potential visitors will be screened using the COVID-19 Visitor Screening Form.



### FOLLOW ALL SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Visitors will be trained on ensuring a safe visit.
