VIDOH Works with DHS to Test Territorial Head Start Programs

US Virgin Islands — The Virgin Islands Department of Health (VIDOH) and the Department of Human Services (DHS) have teamed up to provide COVID-19 testing for all participants in the Territory's Head Start Program.
