



Positive: A laboratory positive reported case with zika virusspecific nucleic acid in serum and/or IgM antibodies in serum and confirmatory plaque reduction neutralization testing to differentiate potential cross-reactive antibodies.

Saint Thomas

Negative: A laboratory negative reported case without zika virusspecific nucleic acid and/or IgM antibodies in serum. Pending: Any reported/tested awaiting laboratory diagnosis.




