

Employee Illness Decision Tree

Do you have vomiting and/or diarrhea?



DO NOT WORK

- Go home. Do not return to work for at least 24 hr. after symptoms end (72 hr. during an outbreak investigation)
- Report symptoms to person in charge
- Person in charge notifies regulatory authority of employee diagnosed with Salmonella, Shigella, E. coli, Norovirus, or Hepatitis A virus

Does someone in your household have vomiting and/or diarrhea?



WORK WITH PRECAUTIONS

- Practice frequent handwashing
- Avoid bare-hand contact with ready-to-eat foods or clean dishes
- Go home at first sign of vomiting and/or diarrhea

Do you have a cough, sore throat, fever or runny nose?



WORK WITH PRECAUTIONS

- Notify person in charge of sore throat and fever
- Reinforce proper handwashing
- Avoid bare-hand contact with ready-to-eat foods or clean dishes
- Go home at first sign of vomiting and/diarrhea

NO RESTRICTION FROM NORMAL WORK DUTIES

- Contact your local health department with concerns about other symptoms or conditions
