Reporting Suspected Chikungunya Cases to USVI Department of Health

If you see a patient with the following symptoms, please report it to the USVI DOH:

Acute onset of fever >38°C or >101°F

AND

• Severe arthralgia or arthritis not explained by another medical condition

How to report suspected chikungunya cases to the USVI DOH:

- 1) Fill out the "Dengue and Chikungunya Reporting Form" available at www.healthvi.org/forms. The yellow highlighted fields are mandatory, but please do your best to fill out all fields.
- 2) Make TWO copies of the filled-out "Dengue and Chikungunya Reporting Form."
- 3) Send the FIRST copy of the form to Dr. Esther Ellis at the USVI DOH by fax (preferred) or mail:
